

Filling Vacancies

Appointments If a Vacancy occurs in the office of any member of the Board, the Board will appoint a new member to serve until the next regular election. A new member will be appointed at a regular meeting by a vote of a majority of those present and voting, with such vote being taken within a thirty day period of the announcement of the vacancy. The thirty day requirement may be waived for vacancies being announced during July or August. At the next regular election, a successor shall be elected for the unexpired portion of the term, and the official ballot shall specify the vacancy to be filled.

Oath of Office Appointed Board of Education members shall, before entering upon their official duties, take the oath of office and be sworn in by the town clerk, notary public, or Justice of the Peace.
