

Orientation of Board Members

Experienced Board of Education members and the administrative staff shall assist each new member-elect to understand the Board of Education's functions, policies, procedures, and the operation of the school system through the following:

1. New members shall be given selected materials on the responsibilities and authorities of the Board of Education and the Superintendent of Schools
2. New members shall be invited to attend Board meetings and to participate in discussions.
3. New members shall be invited to meet with the superintendent and principal to discuss their duties and responsibilities, and continuing Board members shall be notified and invited to attend such meetings;
4. New members shall be provided with a copy of Board of Education policies and bylaws, Superintendent's administrative regulations and other pertinent materials.
5. New members are encouraged to attend Board of Education workshops for new members approved by the Board of Education.
