

Board of Education Hearings

The Board of Education shall hold a public hearing when so petitioned by one percent of District electors or fifty such electors, whichever is greater, with signatures of the electors verified by the town clerk. Such public hearings must be called for a time and place designated by the Board, not later than three weeks after receipt by the board of such petition.
