Planning for SEL Days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Topics and grade levels for the Susan B Anthony visit. Sarah Z is reaching out to see if 2 groups or two presentations can be done the same day (they can!). We are trying for 'Conflict Resolution Puppet Show' for K-2 and 'Bystander Options' 3-5. ● Online safety speaker~ We want to look into Scott Driscolls fees. LH has emailed him. ● PRIDE~ <i>As Hartland's PRIDE and Joy we demonstrate Perseverance, Respect, Innovation, Diligence, Effort.</i> We discussed this initiative and ways to effectively communicate with parents as well as provide them with resources. Many of them are being addressed during our SEL time blocks.
