## Principal Report- L. Hollingsworth

L. Hollingsworth reported she developed a google survey that went out to teachers of GMHS and Region 7 that teach high school freshmen from Hartland. She states the data gathered will help align curriculum for eighth grade to high school transition. L. Hollingsworth reported Ronnie Alicata, 8th grade LA/Writing teacher, Cindy Smith, 8th grade math teacher, as well as herself will be meeting with teachers at Region 7 on January 24, 2018 for curriculum alignment that will revolve around content general preparedness. She reported at next month's meeting she will have math data from the next round of STAR360 testing. The progress shown will help with aligning any math initiatives. L. Hollingsworth reported that we would be receiving monies from The Capital Area Substance Abuse Grant. She stated these monies help fund M.S. dances, Hartford Stage that visits grades 5 and 6 yearly, and any guest speakers. She reported the school Safety & Climate Committee continue to meet and gather ideas in different areas involving safety, wellness, and any age appropriate topics to be covered. L. Hollingsworth shared that Dave Marlin, our P.E. teacher has been meeting with other teachers in the area to help align a curriculum that would include wellness. She reported that the Growth Mindset Committee is working on gathering data on the impact of learning in specific areas and how to represent what P.R.I.D.E really means to the Hartland School Community.
