Please be aware that recently the CT. State Department of Education has enacted change to the minimum age for automatic entry into public school, effective July 1, 2024. Children must reach age five on or before September 1st of any school year. If you plan to register your child for the 2024-2025 school year, please call the office at 860-653-7207 to pre-register.

In order to prepare for your child's kindergarten year, families are encouraged to attend the Kindergarten Registration. Registration will be held on **Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at 10:30 am.** At registration, children will meet their teacher, Mr. Lovell and will have an opportunity to become acquainted with their classmates.

When you arrive at school with your child on March 26th, please proceed directly to the Library. At this time, we will share information about our school and the kindergarten program. Most important of all, you will have an opportunity to ask questions that you may have.

While all of this is taking place, the children will be in the kindergarten classroom where they will listen to a story and participate in an art activity. Our speech/language teacher and social worker will be on hand to listen in as well. This fun event with snacks and activities is an important part of the orientation process. Children will come again for a visit in August and get to ride the school bus! Mr. Lovell will send a letter during the summer detailing this event.
